

# Volta Grand Prix<sup>®</sup>

## 2010 Volta Grand Prix Round 5

Round 5 of the 2010 Volta GP Karting Championship took place at Summit Point Kart (SPK) on May 1, 2010. Eighteen drivers turned up to race at the first Volta GP event at this track.

### Qualifying

Since the track is fairly long, all drivers were gridded together in our biggest grid yet. Tony Ward (GT2) started from pole with Oliver Rojas (GT2) second, Ary Jogasurya (GT3) third on grid (and on pole in class), Eric Jones (GT2) fourth, and Graham "Cracker" Fuller fifth (and on pole for GT4). There were no GT1 drivers participating.

### Race 1

Tony Ward took the GT2 victory, with Jason "Bananaspeed" Mulveny in second and Erric Jones in third. Ary Jogasurya and Graham "Cracker" Fuller won in the GT3 and GT4 classes, respectively.

### Races 2 and 3

These races were postponed due to technical issues with the karts, a case of water in the track fuel tank which resulted in a number of engine stalling issues. The problems have since been resolved, and these races will be run on June 5, 2010 immediately prior to the Volta GP event scheduled for the same day.

### Championship Points Standings

Currently David Nguyen (yours truly), Eric Jones, Linwood Mishler and Graham Fuller lead the points standings in GT1, GT2, GT3 and GT4, respectively.

### Next Event

The next VGP races take place on Saturday May 22 at Allsports Grand Prix (AGP) in Sterling, Virginia.

That same evening ten drivers from the Volta GP series will team up to race in a 12 Hour Enduro at Summit Point Kart from 10 pm until 10 am. More to come.
